

# SHEET METAL WORKERS

You will perform sheet metal work in Transit's subway and elevated structures, including stations, enclosures and related buildings.

**SALARY AND BENEFITS:** The current minimum salary is \$25.9025 per hour for a 40-hour week increasing to \$28.645 after 3 years. We offer paid holidays, vacation and sick leave, a comprehensive health plan, pension plan and a FREE NYC Transit transportation pass.

## Qualification Requirements:

1. Four years of full-time satisfactory journey-level experience as a sheet metal worker journey-level, fabricating sheet metal from blue prints using sheet metal machinery and shop tools; or
2. Three years of experience as described in "1" above, plus graduation from a recognized trade school or technical school with a major course of study in sheet metal, or a closely related field, totaling at least 600 hours.

**License Requirement:** A motor vehicle driver license valid in the state of New York with no restrictions is required.

**NOTE:** This is a provisional Position. To be considered for permanent civil service status, you will be required to pass a qualifying civil service examination.
