

Penn Station Access is a critical transportation equity project which will improve reliability, reduce travel time, and expand mass transit options throughout the region.

Overnight Construction near Barretto Street and Hunts Point Avenue along Garrison Avenue through June 2025

The Penn Station Access Project is performing overnight construction within the Amtrak right-of-way (ROW) at the following two locations beginning April 7th, 2025, through June 2025:

Hunts Point Avenue and Garrison Avenue:

At this location, we are replacing two collapsed timber walls with a precast concrete block wall.

Barretto Street and Garrison Avenue:

At this location, we are performing excavation work, followed by the installation of soil nails, grouting, and shotcrete, for slope stabilization.

This work is expected to be performed nightly between the hours of 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM. This work must be performed overnight to maintain existing rail service along the Northeast Corridor, the most heavily used passenger rail corridor in the U.S. Our contractor has a sound mitigation plan in place compliant with NYC Noise Control Code and DEP guidelines. We appreciate your understanding and patience while we advance this vital transit equity project.
