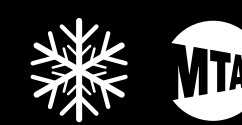


# New York City Subway Severe Winter Weather

- 1** Manhattan Service: 191 St to/from South Ferry. (Trains skip 125 St both directions)
- 2** 3 Av-149 St, Bronx to/from Flatbush Av Brooklyn College, Brooklyn.
- 3** Harlem-148 St, Manhattan to/from Crown Heights-Utica Av, Brooklyn.
- 4** 149 St-Grand Concourse, Bronx to/from Crown Heights-Utica Av, Brooklyn.

- 6** Hunts Point Av, Bronx to/from Brooklyn Bridge-City Hall, Manhattan.
